What You Need to Know About Your Financial Aid Award

Register early to maximize your financial aid!

- To receive the maximum grant monies available to you (*if qualified*), you **must register** for all classes (*including 2nd 8-week term*) by the following date:

Summer 2012 semester: June 22, 2012
Fall 2012 semester: September 28, 2012
Spring 2013 semester: February 15, 2013

- Students who register after these dates **will not receive** an increase in grant monies to cover these classes.

Book Vouchers available!

Book vouchers will be available to those who qualify. To be eligible, you must:

- Be Pell Grant eligible (*as indicated on your award letter*).**
- Students CAN NOT be considered 1st time borrowers.**
- Have completed the financial aid process**
 - Signed award letter on file**
 - Completed Master Promissory Note and Entrance Loan Counseling (*if accepting loans*)**
- Have enough financial aid available to cover the costs of tuition, fees AND books.**

Summer book voucher applications will be available from the Financial Aid Office May 10, 2012 through May 21, 2012.

Drop Deadline is 14 days!

The Add/Drop Policy as follows: you have 7 calendar days to add a class and **14 calendar days to DROP a class**. If you officially drop your class within 14 days from the start of the semester, you will NOT be charged for the dropped class. The add/drop dates are:
