

# MANCHESTER COMMUNITY COLLEGE

## Who needs to file an application for admission to the college?

1. You must file an application and be accepted to a program at Manchester Community College to be eligible for Financial Aid and to graduate from a program of study.
2. If you applied previously but did not register/attend classes for that semester, you must submit a new application for the term that you will be attending.
3. If you were a past student at MCC and stopped attending for 1 year (2 or more semesters), you must re-apply to re-activate your account.




