## What is the Dual Admission Program?

The Dual Admission Program creates a seamless, affordable pathway for students to transfer from MCC to a 4-year college. Once you complete an associate degree at Manchester Community College, you'll transition to one of the University System of New Hampshire institutions to complete a bachelor's degree.

### Get Started:

- 1 Apply to MCC and indicate on the application that you would like to enroll in the Dual Admission Program.
- 2 Upon acceptance, complete the Accuplacer Placement Test and meet with a MCC advisor to learn more.
- 3 Sign the Dual Admission Program agreement outlining the program requirements and return it to an MCC advisor.

### Additional Information

- Admission to the University System of New Hampshire is guaranteed by maintaining a 2.5 grade point average and earning your associate degree, while remaining in good standing. Only courses in which you earn a "C" or better will transfer. It is important to talk to an academic advisor as you plan your courses.
- Admission to majors in USNH colleges is dependent upon meeting major specific requirements. Additional partnership programs have been established with the University System of New Hampshire to guarantee transfer into specific programs.
- The Dual Admission program is best suited for students in the specific degree programs with established dual admission agreements (such as the ones listed on the back of this flyer).
