

ACCUPLACER INFORMATION

- ACCUPLACER is a College Board assessment that determines your knowledge in math, reading and writing as you prepare to enroll in college-level courses. ACCUPLACER is used to identify your strengths and weaknesses in each subject area.
- How Does ACCUPLACER Work?
Test questions are based on your responses to previous questions. Questions will either increase or decrease in difficulty depending on how you respond. ACCUPLACER tests are untimed; however, it is important to allow yourself enough time to complete the test since test results are a key factor in determining the course(s) you can enroll in. ACCUPLACER test results are available immediately following your test.

- Recommended scores for placement in ENGL 110M College Composition:
 - ✓ Writeplacer \geq 5 – 8 (scored from 0 – 8)
 - ✓ Reading Comp \geq 70 – 120 (scored from 0 - 120)
 - ✓ Sentence Skills \geq 70 – 120 (scored from 0 - 120)
- ACCUPLACER scores will be evaluated by MCC's Director of the Academic Success Center, the Running Start Coordinator, and your Running Start College Composition teacher.
